PART 1 GENERAL

1.1 REFERENCES

The publications listed below form a part of this specification to the extent referenced. The publications are referred to in the text by basic designation only.

ENGINEERING MANUALS (EM)

EM 385-1-1(1996) U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Safety and Health Requirements Manual

1.2 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The work includes demolition and removal of resulting rubbish and debris. Rubbish and debris shall be removed from Government property daily, unless otherwise directed, to avoid accumulation at the demolition site. Materials that cannot be removed daily shall be stored in areas specified by the Contracting Officer. In the interest of occupational safety and health, the work shall be performed in accordance with EM 385-1-1, Section 23, Demolition, and other applicable Sections. In the interest of conservation, salvage shall be pursued to the maximum extent possible; salvaged items and materials shall be disposed of as specified.

1.2.1 Special Requirements

The Contractor is advised that lead-based paint is present in Building 10418. Refer to SECTION 2052: DEMOLITION REQUIREMENTS FOR STRUCTURES CONTAINING LEAD-BASED PAINT for the special demolition procedures required for handling this hazards. The following hazardous items may be in the structure:

- a. PCB Ballasts – Lights in building may contain PCB light ballast.
- b. Exit Signs – Exit signs may contain tritium and should be disposed of properly.
- c. Mercury Thermostats/Switches – Mercury thermostats/switches should be disposed of properly.
- d. Mercury fluorescent tubes.

**1.2.2 Phasing of Building 10418 Demolition**

***The customer/owner of Building 10418 will occupy the new F-22 MMF when it is completed. The F-22 MMF shall be completed and accepted, and the customer/owner vacated from Building 10418 prior to the start of the demolition of Building 10418. Building 10418 shall be vacated within 14 days after acceptance of the F-22 MMF.***

**1.2.3. National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) Permit.**

***The contractor is responsible for the building asbestos survey, as required by Clark County, Nevada, and all other requirements for obtaining the NESHAP permit. The contractor shall remove all regulated asbestos-containing materials (RACM) before the demolition of Building 10418. See Section 13280, Building 10418 Nellis AFB Index Asbestos Abatement for the handling of asbestos containing materials.***
